

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

- 7 Sew blocks together in vertical rows, as shown in Quilt Diagram.
- 8 Sew rows together with 1 1-1/2" x (70-1/2") sashing strips.

BORDER ASSEMBLY

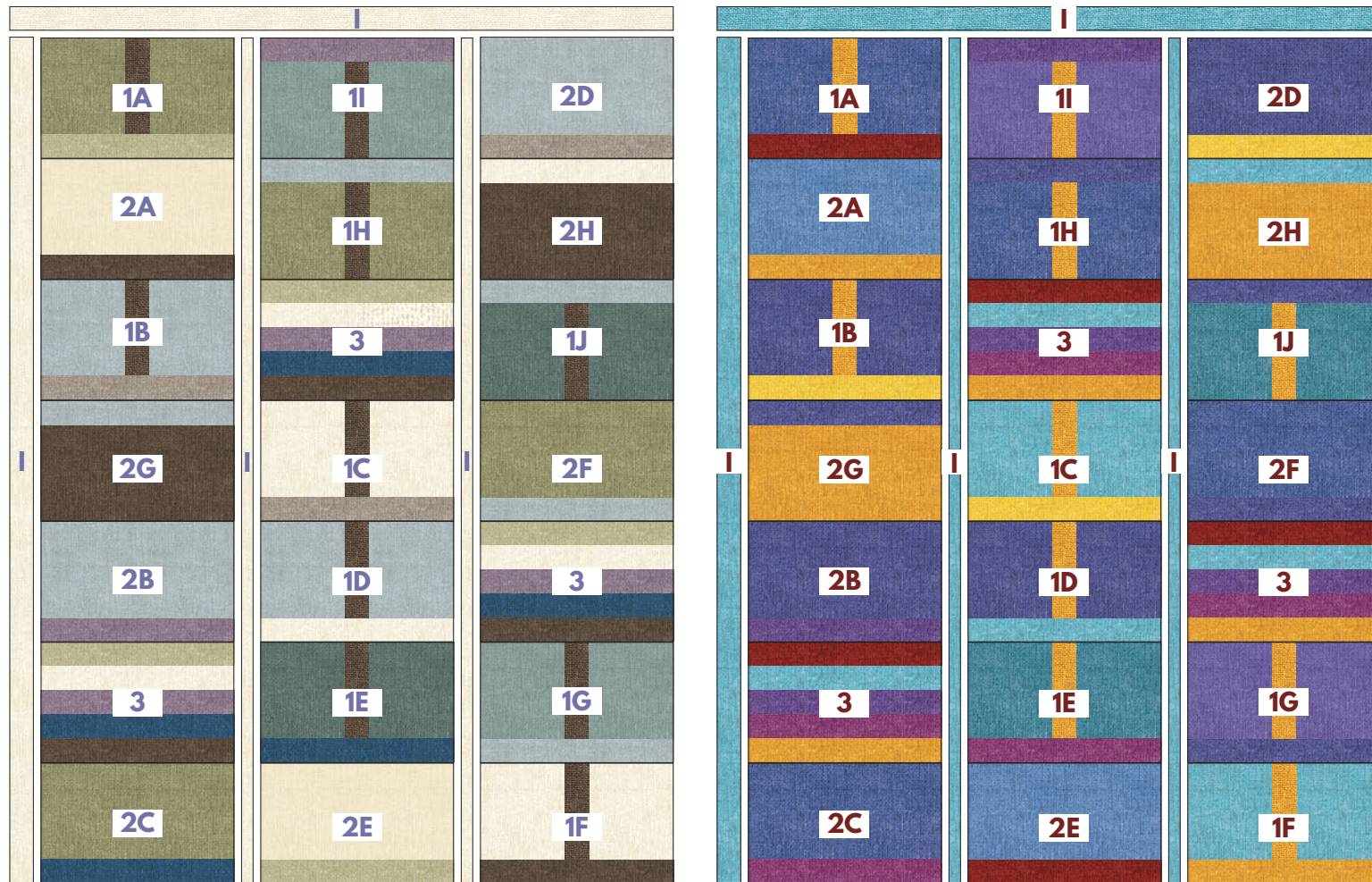
Measure width and length of the quilt top to ensure border sizes, below are our cutting sizes.

- 9 Sew (1) 1 2-1/2" x (70-1/2") strip to each side of Quilt Center.
- 10 Sew (1) 1 2-1/2" x (54-1/2") to top and bottom of Quilt Center.

FINISHED SIZE: 54" X 74"



FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

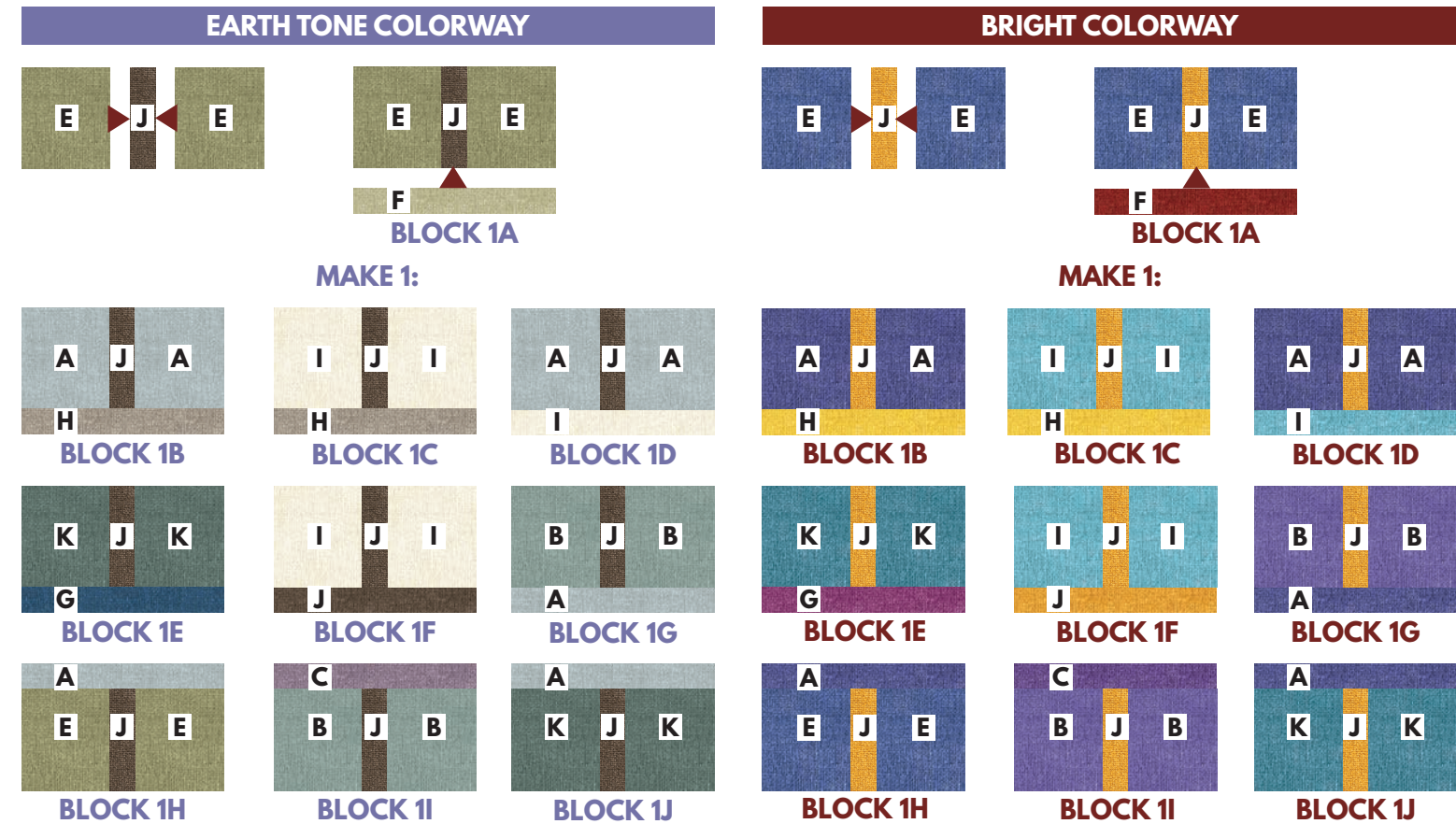

 WOF = Width of fabric | FQ = Fat Quarter | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated

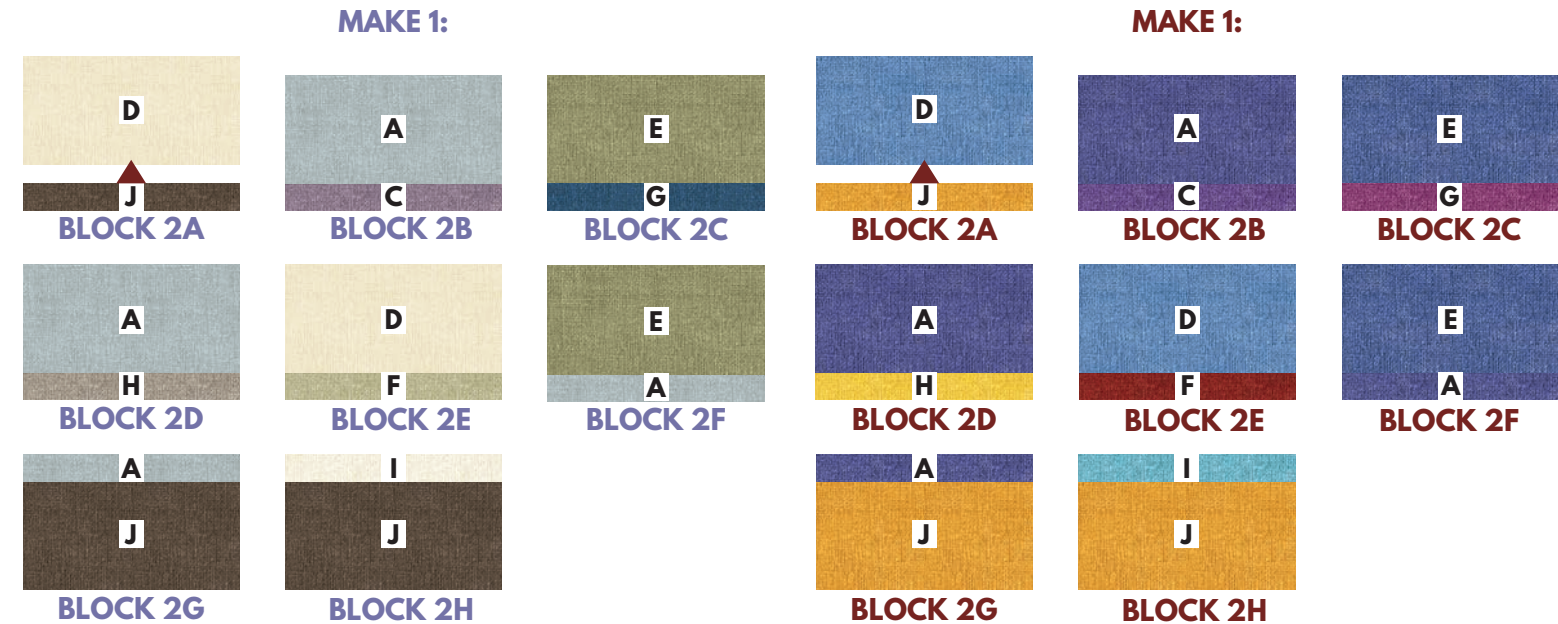
BLOCK 1 ASSEMBLY

- 1 Sew (1) E 7-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to each side of (1) J 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip.
- 2 Sew (1) F 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip to bottom of sewn unit. Square to 10-1/2" x 16-1/2".
- 3 Repeat steps to make 1 each of **Block 1B-Block 1J**. Note top or bottom placement of 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip in each diagram.



BLOCK 2 ASSEMBLY

- 4 Sew (1) J 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip to (1) D 8-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangle. Square to 10-1/2" x 16-1/2".
- 5 Repeat steps to make 1 each of the following. Note top or bottom placement of 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip in each diagram.



BLOCK 3 ASSEMBLY

- 6 Sew 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips together, as shown. Square to 10-1/2" x 16-1/2".
Make 3.
